

# **BADEN-POWELL LYME BAY SCOUTS** (updated: 12/06/09)

## (COSTS)

### **How much will it all cost?**

The cost per Term is: 25.00 (or £75.00/Year) *(there are 3 terms per year, Spring, Summer & Winter)* We are in a position to offer reduced fees & bursaries to potential Scouts, whose families are in receipt of income / disability support type payments. This would reduce our standard fee from £25.00 / term to £12.50 / term or even less. (subject to 90% attendance & other conditions) This is to help cover the cost for the hire of the Village Hall (£391.50 / year), provision of materials, snacks & drinks, etc. *Camping & larger outings might need assistance with costs.* This cost also provides you with the following:

**NOTE on Uniform:** Trousers Dark Blue, Black or Dark Grey may be worn. The Shirt (Khaki pilots type with epaulettes & pockets) & beret (see above) is not needed until the Scout has passed Tenderfoot level & is to be entered as a Scout at the bonfire lit ceremony. At which point the Scout will receive his or her Badges, Scarf, Woggle & Beret. Passing the Tenderfoot level will take at least 4-8 weeks (sessions)

### **The Initial Programme for Tenderfoot Scouts Covers the following:**

- 1.) Background on Scouting & Baden Powell. Leaflet & Talk (very brief, with games to highlight certain aspects, "silent scout", "Remote Control scout", & other fun & challenging Games
- 2.) Learning the Scout Promise & Scout Law. Memory, Round Robin, & other games to assist in this
- 3.) Learn the Salute, Sign & Handshake: how to use, the stories behind each & when to use.
- 4.) learn the Composition of the Union Flag (Union Jack) How to Fold, Hoist, Break & Fly the Flag.
- 5.) Learn how to demonstrate woodcraft signs, to give directions & to leave messages. (20+ to learn)
- 6.) Learn & demonstrate the following knots: Reef Knot, Sheet Bend, clove hitch, Bowline, Round Turn & 2 half Hitches, Sheep Shank, & Common/Simple Rope whipping, West Country Whipping.
- 7.) Take part in the following Patrol & Troop Activities: Hike (no less than 10kms), Weekend Camp (local) & a Pioneering Project, such as tidying up a country footpath, nature reserve or coastline.
